


# Gender Equality





## What is International Women's Day (March 8)?

International Women's Day (March 8) is a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. The day also marks a call to action for accelerating gender parity.








## GENDER EQUALITY IN TAIWAN
